Code of conduct

Kenya Children's Homes is an establishment that prides itself on its integrity, stewardship and Christian values. The purpose of the COC is to ensure all volunteers, staff and children are kept safe at all times as well as to protect the positive reputation of the Home. All staff and volunteers are expected to abide by this COC. Violation of the Code of Conduct could result in termination of volunteer placement.

a) Actively be involved with all relevant group meetings, events and activities.

b) Photography at the Home is strictly forbidden unless approved in advanced by the CEO. Volunteers must not post content to any social media pages to protect the identities of the children and KCH staff without prior permission.

c) Plans can change at short notice, therefore volunteers must be flexible and be ready to adjust when this happens.

d) As a role model within a Christian home and organisation volunteers will refrain from any activity and/or behaviour that does not promote a healthy Christian life-style. For example this may include, but is not restricted to, excessive alcoholic intake, illegal drug use of any kind, smoking on KCH property and use of foul and/or inappropriate language. Volunteers will also not become involved in a romantic relationship with any KCH member, past or present.

e) Volunteers will respect that Kenyan culture may be different from their own and will treat everyone with the highest professional and ethical standards regardless of their age and status.

f) By embarking on a volunteer programme, volunteers give permission for KCH to take and publish their photos and/or videos. Volunteers should advise KCH staff if they do not wish their photos and/or videos to be published.

g) Volunteers will make themselves fully aware of the risks and hazards that could occur for example health, hygiene, disease. Whilst KCH will take the utmost care of all volunteers, personal safety cannot be guaranteed at all times while in Kenya. Volunteers must commit to taking every measure to minimise putting themselves at risk or in harm's way.

h) Volunteers are expected to follow the rules provided by KCH.
